6. Reports from user groups

It was reported that the skate ramp had been damaged by vandalism; the two top roll bars had been removed and one strip of metal was missing. The damaged had been inspected and it was not dangerous at present. Cllr Norman & Gathercole to carry out repairs.

Barrier at other end of car park needs to be straightened or possibly replaced. Cllr Norman & Gathercole to look into action required.

Incidents of owners bringing dogs on to the playing field were reported. On one occasion the owner refused to leave and said that he often brought his dog to the field and would continue to do so. It was agreed that this should be referred to the PC meeting for them to consider issue of a letter to the dog owner advising them to refrain from bringing the dog to the playing field. Additional signs were to be installed advising dog owners that dogs were not permitted on the playing field at any time.

The land next to the bowling green was becoming very overgrown again and it was agreed that the PC should be asked to send a letter to the owner asking for it to be cleared.
