5. Issues connected to the construction of the new community building

6. Condition of play equipment

A large piece of wood had been broken and urgent repairs had been needed for health and safety reasons which had been carried out by ClIrs Norman and Gathercole. It was felt that the damage was mainly caused due to poor quality of workmanship and it was agreed that the Clerk should contact the supplier, Wicksteed, to ask for a meeting with one of their representatives and ClIrs Norman and Gathercole to discuss the situation, as other pieces of equipment were felt to be in danger of similar damage.

Mr. Thompson asked if the slide would be reinstated on the hill after the completion of the construction work for the new community building. Cllr Gathercole advised that it had always been the intention to reinstate the slide and that this had been widely publicised to residents.

Mr. Gowler was not present but had asked the Clerk to raise the issue that he felt the recent scarifying of the field had resulted in the goal mouths on the small pitch being ruined. Cllr Gathercole commented that he had not noticed any damage to the goal mouths but would take a look. It was noted that two home games had been played last weekend.
