5. Issues relating to construction of the new community building

Cllr Gathercole reported that construction work had commenced on 19<sup>th</sup> June and completion was set for 17<sup>th</sup> December 2017; the contractor was Walkers of King's Lynn. The total cost would be over £1m and the project was now fully funded with a grant of over £700k from the Big Lottery Fund and other grants totally over £200k along with a loan from the BC of £150k, which would be repaid from the sale of the Jubilee Hall site when the community building was completed. The concrete would be laid from Wednesday. The project was on time and within budget. There had been some incidents of vandalism on the playing field since the start of construction; the police had been informed and were keeping an eye on the site.

The site had been closed for the start of construction but was now open again; however, it would need to be closed again at some stage. Cllr Norman expressed thanks to Janet Henson for producing the signs to display at the playing field regarding closure and opening of the site to the public. Keys had been provided so that the car park could be fully opened during evenings and weekends for use by sports teams. Lee Chapman and Martin Peckitt had stepped down from the MDCSC committee; thanks, was expressed to them for all of their hard work on the project. The Annual Public Meeting would be taking place on 12<sup>th</sup> July at 8pm.
