5. New committee member

6. Issues relating to construction of the new community building

Cllr Gathercole advised that all doors were now fitted, office nearly completed, flooring down, changing rooms completed, slabs for top soil had been laid, kitchen equipment ordered and would be delivered when required. Electricity to be connected on around 15th January, water supply by end of this month, sewerage connection not yet finalised. Some of the containers used by the construction company had recently been broken into, the police had been informed but nothing appeared to have been stolen. Cllr Norman expressed concern about the break-in of the containers with regard to the

security of the equipment which would be stored in containers in future. He also asked if the footpath which was taken up to the bowls green could be reinstated and the fence moved back as preparation work was needed for next season. Cllr Gathercole agreed to speak to the contractors about this matter.

The Clerk asked if the electric and water supply to the pavilion building would need to be disconnected prior to removal of the building. The water supply was to remain as it was needed for the bowls green but UK Power Networks should be contacted regarding disconnection of the electric supply. This could be disconnected from week commencing 5th February.

Mr Gowler handed over £120 cash from Marshland Saints FC. Each team had played a game recently and done well.
